OBGC COMMUNITY PARK At Freeman Fields

Most outdoor camps are located at the nationally acclaimed OBGC Community Park, 4501 Olney-Laytonsville Road (1½ miles west of Georgia Ave in Olney). The OBGC Community Park was completed in 2002 and features eleven state of the art, laser-graded athletic fields: 5 baseball/softball fields; 4 soccer fields; 1 football field, and 1 field hockey/lacrosse field. The Park also features concessions, indoor restroom facilities and a large pavilion that accommodates 150 people.

Founded in 1969, OBGC's mission is to provide children with a safe athletic environment where they can develop physically and emotionally, build self-esteem and cultivate a life-long interest in sports, health and teamwork. Nearly 7,000 children participate in OBGC programs annually. OBGC is certified with the Maryland Nonprofits' "Seal of Excellence" for nonprofit management.
